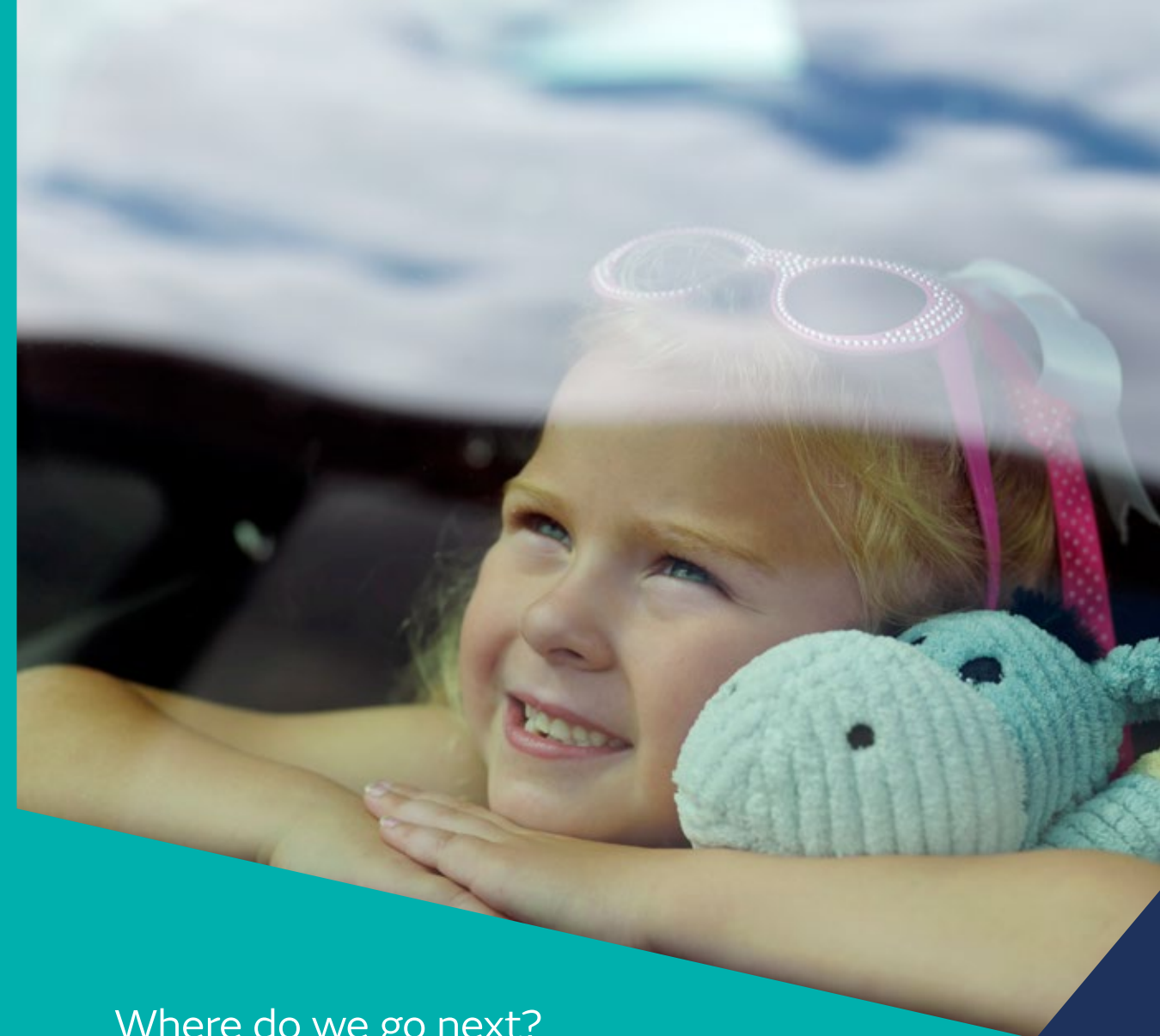

Masterplan 2018–2037

Get involved and help shape

Our masterplan sets out the future development of Doncaster Sheffield Airport – to realise its unique potential, delivering major international connectivity and economic benefit to Yorkshire, the surrounding regions and the UK.

The masterplan will see the airport and wider site deliver...

Passenger operation by 2037
Core growth scenario:
up to 4.7 million passengers

High growth scenario:
up to 7.2 million passengers

Cargo operation by 2037
Core growth scenario:
up to 70,000 tonnes

High growth scenario:
up to 176,500 tonnes

- Major terminal enhancement: Terminal size doubled with expanded check-in, security, departure and immigration areas. New retail facilities to enhance the customer experience.
- 1.5 million sq ft of airside development: Expanded cargo operations, general and business aviation facilities and a dedicated Maintenance Repair Overhaul (MRO) campus.
- Over 3 million sq ft of landside logistics and advanced manufacturing facilities.
- 2–3,000 new residential homes on the site.
- New retail, hotel and leisure complex Including community facilities – all integrated with new housing and employment areas.

High growth scenario:
£6.5 billion by 2037

- 7,800 new jobs and £900 million of construction investment
- £159 million boost to the region's tourism economy, creating an additional 565 jobs
